2003 - project

- Good medical care preferably led by a consultant ortho-geriatrician which minimises medical complications and facilitates rehabilitation
- Early multidisciplinary rehabilitation which promotes mobility and self-care, preparing patients for return home.
- Supported discharge schemes with community rehabilitation which, with the above, result in early return home, thus meeting patients' wishes and at the same time reducing length of stay and service costs
- Costs and quality of care are not in conflict: good care, promptly delivered, ensures substantial efficiency savings
